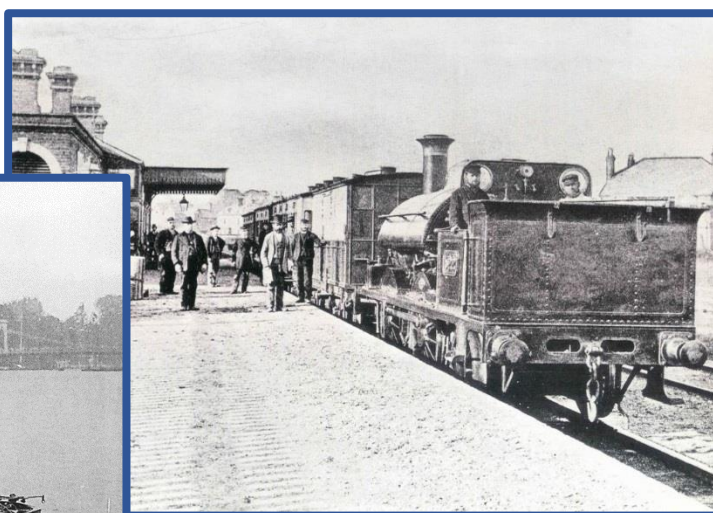

**Great Marlow was for centuries a significant inland port. By the early nineteenth century the Thames was a major commercial artery, but on 1<sup>st</sup> June, 1838 the Great Western Railway reached Maidenhead. This permanently changed the role of the river and quickly altered the town of Marlow for ever.**
