

# What did the Romans ever do for Bourne End?

Did the Romans build a road and a crossing here?

We will look at 'known' Roman Roads in the Chilterns and show how the 'Beacons of the Past' LiDAR data has helped reinterpretation. We will explore a new alignment of the Roman Road in Hodgemoor Wood (Seer Green) on the likely route from Verulamium to Silchester.

Below is a LiDAR image of the best-preserved section of Roman Road in the Chilterns. But where it crosses the Thames remains unproven, although Bourne End is a potential candidate.
